

Circle the picture that is the **same** as the **first** one. Then color in all the pictures.




























I will ask the Holy Spirit to help find all children who are lost.

Holy Spirit, teach me right from wrong. Help me find the true pathway to heaven.



Find the identical fish!




THOSE IS NUMBER THREE AND NUMBER EIGHT


Dear God, with your power I can really help other people.

Draw the slice of pizza to match the first one.






I will share all of my food with my family and friends.



Circle the picture that is **different**. Then color in all the pictures.


























I will stand watch to keep evil out of my soul.
