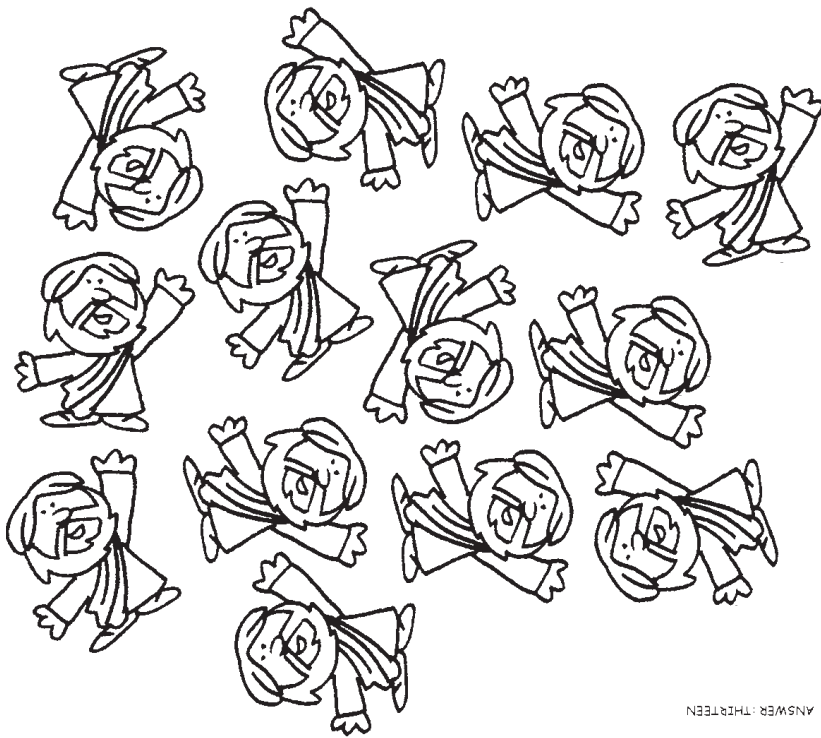


PUZZLE
